Outline:

Up to eighty physiologists from countries around the world will participate in the Seventh IUPS Teaching Workshop in Kobe, Japan, August 1-4, 2009. Registration continues until June 1, 2009. This Workshop will build on work accomplished in the previous six Workshops associated with IUPS Congresses. The program will include interactive presentations on current issues in physiology education, a poster discussion session, and demonstration of computer-based physiology simulations and student data-acquisition labs. Throughout the Workshop participants will work in small groups to discuss and develop five topics, one of which will continue revision of the IUPS Sourcebook of Practical Experiments in Physiology Requiring Minimal Equipment. Other discussion topics will be determined by participants' interests as determined during the registration process. As before, a detailed report of the Workshop's proceedings will be published in *Advances in Physiology Education*.
